MINUTES

Meeting of 16 July 2007, from 15.00 to 18.30
and 17 July 2007, from 9.00 to 1
BRUSSELS

The meeting opened at 15.02 on Monday 16 July 2007, with Marcin Libicki (Chairman) in the chair.

1. Adoption of agenda (PE 376.705)

The agenda was adopted.

The chairman announced that Diana Wallis had presented her apologies for not being present due to a mission. The chairman announced further, that item 8, item 37 and 38 had been postponed to a later meeting, and that item 41 (a B-item) concerning deep vein thrombosis, at the request of Arlene McCarthy would be treated at a later meeting given further information from the petitioner. The chairman pointed out that items 5-9 would be taken after 16 pm and that the meeting consequently would begin with items 14-17 dealing with petitions linked to Equitable Life, for which Mairead McGuinness would be present. The president announced finally that petitioners would be present for item 10, item 21, item 31 and item 33. The agenda was approved.

2. Approval of minutes of 2 May 2007 (PE 388.662)

The minutes were approved.

3. Chairman's announcements

The Chairman draw to the attention of members that following the decision of the Coordinators at their last meeting the petitions on Radio Cope and TeleMadrid have both been placed in the B section at this meeting (items 49 & 51). The chairman further suggested that petition 988/2005 by Peter Kaiser (German) may be closed as the petitioner had not responded to requests for further information sent to him in March. Members agreed.

4. Other business

The chairman stated that a petition may be presented at the meeting by a group of Scottish Farmers.

Carlos José Iturgaiz Angulo took the floor and asked that his report on the deliberations of the Committee during the year 2006 was taken as the first item, since he had other obligations later in the afternoon. The chairman and the members agreed.

5. Report on the deliberations of the Committee on Petitions during the year 2006 (INI 2007/2132) Rapporteur: ITURGAIZ (PPE-DE) - consideration of a draft report

Speakers: the chairman, Carlos José Iturgaiz Angulo (rapporteur) and Michael Cashman.
The chairman announced that there would be a second deliberation in September, when the report would be available in all working languages. He also announced that since David Hammerstein Mintz, who had asked for the postponement of items 5-9, was present now, the agenda points would be taken in the original order.

The meeting opened at 10.05 with Marcin Libicki, chairman, in the chair.

25. Chairman's announcement concerning coordinators decisions

The chairman announced the following:

- The "One seat petition" had been raised once again because the chairman had still not received a reply from the President of the Parliament to a letter sent last December. The coordinators had subsequently urged him to write another letter to the President to draw his attention to this.
- The fact that the Irish authorities had begun to excavate in an area of vital historical and archaeological significance at Tara, as part of the M3 motorway development had been discussed by the coordinators, who had instructed the chairman to write to Commissioner Stavros Dimas and the Irish Environment Minister, John Gormley, expressing the Committee's deep concern.

- In the light of the difficulties at a recent meeting of the Conference of Presidents concerning the approval of requests for reports by the Committee, the coordinators had emphasized the need to convey to the Conference of Presidents the specificity of the Committee's requirements.
