Order by His Honour Judge Behrens sitting as a Judge of the High Court in Leeds

Permission is hereby refused.

Reasons:

1. The actual complaint in relation to Price Waterhouse Coopers ("PWC") has been considered by the Defendant on two previous occasions – 4th March 2008 and 6th October 2009. Accordingly the complaint has been investigated. In my view the Defendant was entitled to take the view that the report of Sir Jonathan Parker in relation to Equitable Life did not affect the position and that there was no new evidence.
2. The application is out of time and no good reason has been provided to extend the time.
 - The costs of preparing the Acknowledgment of Service are to be paid by the Claimant to the Defendant in the sum of £ 500 plus VAT.
